On October 25, 2023, the Court issued an Order Addressing IGG DNA and Order for *In Camera* Review that addressed the State's motion to prevent the disclosure of the Investigative Genetic Genealogy ("IGG") information to the defense and the defense's motion to compel discovery of all information pertaining to the IGG investigation.
