IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant abide by the following conditions of release:

☐ Defendant is Ordered released

☐ On own recognizance

☐ Placed on probation

☐ Case is Dismissed

☐ If currently on probation, report to your probation officer immediately and follow all rules, conditions and reporting requirements established by your probation officer.

☐ Immediately contact Pre-Trial release services (misdemeanor probation office), complete the Pre-Trial Release Notification Letter and Agreement and follow all rules, conditions and reporting requirements established by your pre-trial release officer.

☐ Do not consume or possess any alcoholic beverages or enter into any establishment where the majority of their business is derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages (for example a bar or tavern).

☐ Do not use, possess or be in close proximity to any mind altering substance, controlled substance or drug unless you possess a valid prescription for that substance.

☐ Submit to evidentiary testing for alcohol and/or drugs as requested by Pre-Trial release services or a Peace Officer at defendant's expense.

☐ Do not drive or sit in the front seat of any motor vehicle, including a pickup truck.

☐ Abide by any No Contact Order and its conditions.

☐ Defendant shall sign a waiver of extradition prior to release.

☐ Defendant shall not commit any new misdemeanors or felonies.

☐ Defendant shall not leave Payette, Washington, Malheur, Canyon, Gem or Ada Counties. Leaving this area, except to obtain emergency medical care, may be prosecuted as the crime of Escape, and subject the defendant to the penalties of Idaho Code 18-1505 or 18-2506.

☐ Defendant may not leave the State of Idaho and Oregon.

☐ Defendant shall submit to random & observed drug & alcohol testing no less than _____ time(s) per week. Testing shall be administered through Pre-trial release services or, if permitted by PTR services, by a facility approved by the courts of the county where the defendant resides. If the defendant does not test with PTR services in Payette County, the defendant must ensure the testing facility used send the results to PTR services in Payette County within 14 days of any test. At any time a test is required, and the defendant appears for the test without the funds to pay for the test, the defendant will submit a sample and then IMMEDIATELY present himself/herself to the court and remain there until the court reviews the matter.

☐ Within 5 days or release from custody, defendant MUST make contact with appointed counsel and thereafter maintain regular contact to ensure that counsel and defendant will be prepared for any court proceedings. Contact at least 1 time every 3 days. Attend all future court proceedings.

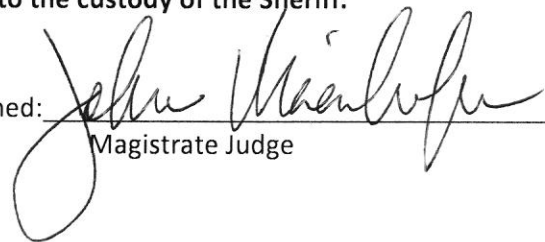
☐ Defendant is ordered to submit to ☐ GPS or ☐ Alcohol monitoring and shall make arrangements with a provider approved by Pretrial Release Officer, ☐ device must be fitted prior to release.

Other:

Failure by defendant to comply with the rules and/or reporting conditions and/or requirements of release as ordered by the Court, may result in the revocation of release and returned to the custody of the Sheriff.
