
MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME FOR
FILING OF PRETRIAL MOTIONS

COMES NOW, the Defendant, by and through Defendant’s attorneys of record the Idaho State Public Defender and hereby moves this Honorable Court for entry of an order enlarging time for filing pretrial motions.

Per Idaho Criminal Rule 12(d), “Motions under Rule 12(b) must be filed within 28 days after entry of a plea of not guilty or seven days before trial whichever is earlier. In felony cases, motions under Rule 12(b) must be brought on for hearing within 14 days after file or 48 hours before trial, whichever is earlier. The court may shorten or enlarge time and, for good cause shown or for excusable neglect, may relieve a party of failure to comply with this rule.”

The Defendant entered a plea of not guilty at district court arraignment in front of the Honorable Judge Stuchlik on April 3, 2026. Per Idaho Criminal Rule 12(d) the time to file pretrial motions expires May 1, 2026. This deadline is unrealistic and unreasonable in this case. The Defendant is charged with Murder. This is a complex case where the prosecution has indicated that the investigation of this case is still ongoing, and the discovery process is ongoing as well. Defense counsel respectfully moves the court to enlarge the time for filing pretrial motions under Idaho Criminal Rule 12(d) to August 1, 2026.


