- I, Craig H. Durham, under penalty of perjury depose and say:
 - 1. Appellant's brief is due on or before August 15, 2023.
 - 2. One previous extension of time has been granted.
- 3. Counsel respectfully requests additional time in which to complete the opening brief. This is a lengthy and complex case with an extensive and voluminous record on appeal. It began as a capital case below and proceeded as such until close to trial. After a weeks-long jury trial, Ms. Vallow Daybell was found guilty of two counts of first-degree murder, conspiracy to commit murder, criminal conspiracy, and grand theft. The district court sentenced her to multiple fixed life sentences with no possibility of parole. The Clerk's Record is over 2,000 pages, and the transcripts are over 5,000 pages. Counsel has started his review of the record and the potential issues in the case but needs additional time.
