
An Order Re: Verified Petition for Writ of Prohibition was entered by this Court on September 26, 2025. Thereafter, an Order Granting Verified Petition to Intervene (Idaho State Legislature) was entered by this Court on October 2, 2025. The parties to this matter and *amici curiae* have filed briefs with this Court; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that oral argument in this matter is set for Friday, January 23, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in Boise. Pursuant to Idaho Appellate Rule 37(b), each side will be

allowed 30 minutes for argument. Counsel for Respondent and Intervenor-Respondent shall share the 30 minutes allotted to Respondent. Counsel for Respondent and Intervenor-Respondent shall allocate the time for argument between themselves prior to oral argument. In the absence of an agreement, on request of either party at least fourteen (14) days before oral argument, an allocation of time will be made by the Supreme Court at least seven (7) days before oral argument.
