3. PETITIONERS' SECOND UNOPPOSED EXPEDITED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME and DECLARATION OF MARVIN K. SMITH IN SUPPORT OF SECOND

UNOPPOSED EXPEDITED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME were filed by counsel for Petitioners on March 18, 2026, and an Order [Granting] Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time was entered by this Court on March 19, 2026.

4. A JOINT NOTICE OF AGREEMENT AND RESOLUTION OF ATTORNEY FEE AWARD was filed by counsel for Petitioners on March 25, 2026, advising this Court that the parties have come to an agreement resolving Respondent Tax Commission's request for attorney fees and as such, there is no need for the Court to issue a ruling on Respondent's request for attorney fees.
