
Therefore, THIS COURT ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The hearing for these matters is set for sixty (60) minutes. Each side will be allowed thirty (30) minutes for argument. Respondent and Intervenors-Respondents shall allocate the time for argument between and among themselves prior to the commencement of the hearing.

In the absence of such agreement, on the request of any party at least fourteen (14) days before the hearing, an allocation of time will be made by the Supreme Court at least seven (7) days before the hearing. See *I.A.R. 37*.
