
In order to ensure the safe operation of public business, on September 29, 2022, the public is prohibited from bringing any containers into the Supreme Court building including, but not limited to, purses, shoulder bags, brief cases, backpacks, rolling cases, or computer bags. In order to adequately consider and implement any requests for accommodation pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act or other exemption, a request must be made in writing no later

than 5:00 p.m. on September 27, 2022. Information on how to request accommodation may be found at <https://isc.idaho.gov/main/ADA> If any requests are granted, all containers that are permitted into the building will be required to pass through a scanning machine at the entry control point and will be subject to search by the Idaho State Police.

Attorneys appearing at the hearing on behalf of a party in the case may bring containers into the building to facilitate their representation.


