I found the following errata in the Brief in Support of a Petition for Issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, which I wish to correct as follows.

Page 3, first full paragraph, last sentence: The word “with” should be “within”; the statement midway through that sentence should be that a timely Petition for a Referendum “must be filed within sixty days of the Legislature’s adjournment.”

Page 8, second line: The reference to a paragraph of the Petition should be to Paragraph 13, not to Paragraph 11 and this line should read: “As Paragraph ~~11~~13 of the Petition summarized:”

Page 12, last paragraph, second sentence: The word “not” is missing from the first clause of the sentence, which should read: “Petitioners not challenging legislative action or inaction need not show support in every Legislative District; those who do must.”
