WHEREAS, it appearing that the above entitled cases should be consolidated for purposes of oral argument and issuance of the Court's Opinion; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Docket Nos. 48760-2021 and 48784-2021 shall be consolidated for purposes of oral argument and the issuance of the Court's Opinion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument in this matter is scheduled for Tuesday, June 29, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom Video Conferencing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each side will be allowed 30 minutes for argument. The parties on each side shall allocate the time for argument between and among themselves prior to the commencement of oral argument. In the absence of such agreement, on the request of any party at least 14 days before oral argument, an allocation of time will be made by the Supreme Court at least seven (7) days before argument.
