ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND
TIME TO HEAR I.C.R. 12(b) MOTIONS


On August 27, 2020 Defendant filed a motion requesting an order to extend time for a hearing on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss. I.C.R. 12(d) provides that a motion to dismiss "must be brought on for hearing within 14 days after filing or 48 hours before trial, whichever is earlier," and that "the court may shorten or enlarge the time [for hearing]...for good cause shown..." The Motion to Extend Time cites to counsel's need to obtain transcripts of the preliminary hearing to prepare for the hearing.

The Court, having considered the motion, and in the absence of an objection by the State, finds that good cause for the extension has been shown. Therefore, the August 27 Motion to Extend Time to Hear I.C.R. 12(b) Motions is GRANTED.
