
ORDER RE MOTION TO
RECONSIDER
ORDER GOVERNING
COURTROOM CONDUCT

On July 8, 2020, this Court issued an Order Governing Courtroom Conduct. The Order allows for one media outlet to do an audio and visual broadcast of the Preliminary Hearing scheduled for August 3 and 4. On July 17, 2020, the State filed a Motion to Reconsider in the matter of cameras in the courtroom and the allowance of visual livestream.

The Court is mindful of the need to balance (1) the Constitutional right of the Defendant to a fair trial; (2) the public's right to information in conjunction with the Constitutional and statutory rights of the media to attend the proceedings; (3) the Idaho Supreme Court orders to limit courtroom access due to COVID-19; and (4) the Idaho Supreme Court order titled "In Re: Jury Trials" that currently governs the livestreaming of court proceedings. With these factors in mind, pursuant to Idaho Court Administrative Rule 45 and the aforementioned Order Governing Courtroom Conduct, the Court will continue to allow one media outlet to do a video and audio broadcast of the Preliminary Hearing for the Defendant in this case. All other provisions of the Order Governing Courtroom Conduct will remain intact.
