
**ORDER TO SEAL**

On Tuesday, January 3, 2023, the Court received an *Ex Parte Motion [...] and Ex Parte Memorandum in Support of Ex Parte Motion [...]*. Following an *in camera* review of the supplemental pleading the Court makes the following finding:

Pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(g)(15) the Court finds that the *Ex Parte Motion [...] and Ex Parte Memorandum in Support of Ex Parte Motion [...]* reference information that is expressly exempt from public disclosure and are proper at this time as *ex parte* documents. See I.C.A.R. 32(g)(15). Accordingly, the Court determines that temporarily sealing the documents are necessary to protect individual privacy rights and interests, and to preserve the Parties' rights to a fair trial, and such action is no broader than necessary to protect this fundamental right.
