On Wednesday, January 4, 2023, the Court received an *Ex Parte Supplement to Defendant's Motion to Continue*. Following an *in camera* review of the supplemental pleading the Court makes the following finding:

Pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(g)(15) the Court finds that the *Ex Parte Supplement to Defendant's Motion to Continue* references information that is expressly exempt from public disclosure and proper as an *ex parte* document. See I.C.A.R. 32(g)(15). Accordingly, the Court determines that sealing the document is necessary to protect individual privacy rights and interests, and to preserve the Parties' rights to a fair trial, and such action is no broader than necessary to protect this fundamental right.
