

On Subpoenas for Trial

In accordance with Idaho Criminal Rule 17(a), and upon argument heard in open court on February 23, 2023, this Court orders the Clerk of the Court to file all subpoenas issued in this case under temporary seal, pursuant to Idaho Court Administrative Rule 32(i)(2)(E) in order to preserve the parties' rights to a fair trial. The Court finds that sealing private personal identifying information contained in subpoenas is the least restrictive measure consistent with privacy interests necessary to preserve the fundamental right to a fair trial.
