**ORDER TO CLOSE A PORTION OF
THE HEARING AND SEAL RECORD
AND EXHIBITS**

The Court held a hearing on Defendant's Motion to Change Venue on October 5, 2021. Good cause appearing, the Court hereby orders:


After due consideration of the factors set forth in I.C.A.R. 32, and in consideration that a likelihood exists that the parties may be prejudiced by discussion of or dissemination of information already sealed or to be sealed, the Court determined during the hearing that certain parts of the proceedings discussing exhibits that are potentially inflammatory in nature and that have the potential of unduly influencing potential jurors should be sealed and the proceedings were closed. Those parts of the hearing were conducted in a Zoom "breakout room" with the presence of the Court Reporter.

The Court determined that those parts of the hearing that occurred inside breakout rooms in Zoom during the Motion to Change Venue Hearing held on October 5, 2021 will be closed and the transcript of such proceedings shall be sealed. In addition, the Exhibits admitted at the hearing are sealed. The closure of the hearing and exhibits sealed are for this limited purpose and this Order is no broader than necessary to protect the parties' interests in preventing disclosure of potentially

prejudicial information. Finally, the Court determines that there were no other reasonable alternatives to closing the proceeding, and sealing the transcript and exhibits.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
