**ORDER TO SEAL**


*State's Motion for Introduction of Evidence  
Pursuant to I.R.E. 401, 402, 403, 404(b)*

On Thursday, January 26, 2023, the Court received the State's MOTION TO SEAL STATE'S MOTION FOR INTRODUCTION OF EVIDENCE PURSUANT TO I.R.E. 401, 402, 403, & 404(B).

Pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(i)(1) the Court finds that temporarily sealing the *State's Motion for Introduction of Evidence Pursuant to I.R.E. 401, 402, 403, 404(b)* is appropriate until the Court can call a hearing to determine and make a finding of fact as to whether the interest in privacy or public disclosure predominates. Accordingly, the Court determines the temporary sealing is necessary to protect individual privacy rights and interests, and to preserve the Parties' rights to a fair trial, and such action is no broader than necessary to protect this fundamental right.
