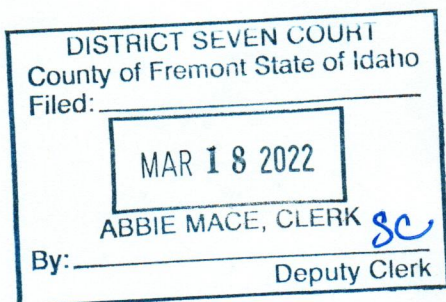


In response to the Court's Order For Examination, the Court orders as follows:

After due consideration of the factors set forth in I.C.A.R. 32, and finding a likelihood exists that both the State and the Defense could be prejudiced by discussion or dissemination of information already sealed, the Court finds that a compelling interest is at stake in the need to preserve a fair trial, and no reasonable alternative exists to protect this fundamental right except to seal the Order For Examination at this time.


