ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


Pursuant to Idaho Court Administrative Rule 45(d), the Administrative District Judge has authority to promulgate rules governing audio/visual recordings and media coverage within a courthouse and outside of a courtroom. The purpose of the Rule is to avoid activity that would be disruptive to court operations, impede the activity of citizens who have business within the courthouse, or might compromise courthouse security.

Accordingly, as to the Madison County Courthouse and any hearing or court proceeding in this matter, no member of the media shall conduct conferences, interviews, or news reporting from the courthouse hallways or other common areas. Any conferences, interviews or reporting from the courthouse grounds shall be done in a manner not impede foot traffic on the sidewalks in front of the Courthouse or obstruct access to the Courthouse.

Violations of this Order may subject the violator to a charge of contempt. The clerk shall post this Order at conspicuous locations within the courthouse and provide copies to all interested parties.
